

ONE-TIME & THREE-MONTH MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

JIROAM, Inc. dba 321 Slammer (321) is a private, members only men's club and is not open to the general public. By signing below, you hereby acknowledge that you have read and understand the contents of this application, will abide by 321's rules and procedures, and understand the nature of 321's business and the attendant risks by entering into the premises. If you are offended by explicit sexual language, nudity, homosexual imagery and sexual activity between consenting adults then you should neither become a member nor enter the premises.

21 OR OVER – No one under 21 years of age may enter or become a member. You MUST provide an original, current and valid government-issued I.D. with photo and date of birth (driver license, passport, or military ID) every time you enter the building. You must your current ID even if you are an active member. No scans, photos, apps, or copies are acceptable.

NO DRUGS OR ILLEGAL ACTIVITIES – 321 prohibits the sale, consumption and/or possession of any illegal or controlled substances on the premises at any time. We have a zero tolerance policy and offenders are required to leave the premises immediately. 321 prohibits prostitution in any forms, whether real or perceived, on the premises. All members have a responsibility to inform management of any person soliciting the use of drugs or sex for money on the premises.

<u>DRESS CODE</u> – Members must be fully dressed in traditionally male street attire when entering or exiting the club. Costumes, colognes, and other body fragrances are prohibited. Nudity is permitted in select areas. You may rent a locker to store clothes or belongings if you would like to change or be nude.

<u>PRIVACY</u> – Cellphones, cameras, audio recorders, video equipment and other electronic devices <u>are not allowed</u> in the club. You must leave those items in your vehicle or check them at the window prior to entry. If you're found to have one of these items inside, <u>you will be asked to leave and escorted out</u>. Politely say "No" if you don't want the attention of another member. Also, respect the right of another member to say "No" to you.

SAFETY – Glass bottles are not allowed anywhere in the premises. All beverages will be served in and consumed from plastic cups. Members may not carry firearms or weapons of any type onto the premises. Members may rent a box at the window to check in wallets, keys, mobile phones, personal electronic equipment and other small valuables. Members may also rent a locker to store clothing, bags and larger items. 321 is not responsible for the loss of or damage to any personal property of its members. Members agree to hold harmless 321 and its staff for any loss or injury that may occur on these premises. Disruptive behavior is not permitted, including fighting, violent activity, loud noises and verbal abuse. Be prepared before you enter the club, making sure you bring all needed items upon initial entry. When you leave 321, exercise due regard in the parking lots and surrounding neighborhood. Do not loiter, consume alcohol, engage in sexual activities, dump trash or become loud in these areas.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK – You understand that you may be subjected to or engage in sexual contact and activity at 321. By signing this Application and becoming a member of 321, you expressly assume all risks of engaging in sexual activity, including the possibility of contracting or transmitting sexually transmitted diseases, or other communicable diseases. Further, you understand that 321 shall be held harmless from any and all acts and omissions performed by other Members, including STD and STI transmissions, unwanted physical contact and acts of negligence not directly attributable to the staff of 321. Express acknowledgment of this provision is a condition precedent to becoming a member of 321.

<u>ALCOHOL</u> – 321 is a Bottle Club and does not sell alcohol. You may bring alcoholic beverages into the club in their original, unopened containers. You must show the window attendant your container so it can be properly labeled. You cannot remove alcohol containers after you bring them into the club. You may share your alcohol with other members only if you are present and give consent. It is YOUR responsibility to remember what type and brand of liquor you have. You may be asked to provide your membership card to prove identity. Excess wine and beer are discarded when the club closes for the evening. You may not bring in water bottles, other non-alcoholic beverages, or food (including empty containers). For safety of all members and staff, 321 may limit or deny serving alcoholic beverages to its members. 321 will call a taxi for any member who requests or requires one.

- Membership Cardholders Liquor (i.e. rum, vodka, whiskey) will be labeled with your name, membership card number and expiration date and will be kept behind the bar for the duration of your membership. Any bottle that remains after your membership expiration date will be held for a period of two weeks. If your membership is not renewed by that time, the bottle and its contents will be discarded. It is your responsibility to get a new label for any alcohol already behind the bar at the time of membership renewal
- One-time Members All alcoholic beverages brought into the club by one-time members are discarded upon closing.

ONE-TIME MEMBERSHIP – One-time memberships expire when the club closes that evening or when you leave the building, whichever comes first.

THREE-MONTH MEMBERSHIP – You may purchase a three-month membership, which includes your first visit. During future visits members are required to present their valid membership card with a valid I.D. and pay an entrance fee. The expiration date of the membership is stamped on the back of the card. 321 is not responsible for lost cards. If you do not have your card, you must purchase a new three-month membership or pay for a one-time membership.

IN/OUT POLICY – If you need to leave the club for any reason after entry, you may purchase a re-entry card. The card can be purchased at the front window and allows the member to re-enter the club at no additional charge for a period of two hours after the card is issued. If you return outside that two-hour period or fail to purchase the card prior to leaving the building, you will be required to pay the full entrance fee.
